The November 7, 2017 Coordinated Election will be conducted as a Mail Ballot election, meaning all voters with an active voter registration status will have their ballots delivered to them by mail. A Voter Service and Polling Center will be open for registration, change of address and replacement ballots. Ballots may also be dropped off at the Elizabeth Walmart Ballot Drop Box, located by Customer Service.
