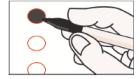

Sample Ballot

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Ballot questions referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot questions initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. A "yes/for" vote on any ballot question is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a "no/against" vote on any ballot question is a vote against changing current law or existing circumstances.

Elbert County

Ballot Question 1A

Shall the term limits imposed by state law and in Article XVIII, Section 11, of the Colorado Constitution on the office of Sheriff of Elbert County be modified so as to permit the current office holder of the office of Sheriff of Elbert County, Shayne Heap, to seek and, if the voters of Elbert County choose to re-elect, to serve a third consecutive term?

BALLOT ISSUE 5A

WITHOUT INCREASING THE TAX RATE OF 1.676 MILLS CURRENTLY BEING LEVIED BY ELIZABETH PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT FOR THE PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE ON GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, SHALL DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED IN 2018 BY \$51,350 ABOVE THE AMOUNT APPROVED BY VOTERS IN MAY 2000 AND BY SUCH ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS GENERATED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY CONTINUING TO COLLECT SUCH 1.676 MILLS TO BE USED FOR GENERAL FUND PURPOSES INCLUDING:

- (1) INCREASING MAINTENANCE OPERATIONS TO IMPROVE PARK CONDITIONS;
 - (2) EXPANDING RECREATION PROGRAMMING TO BETTER SERVE YOUTH, ADULTS, AND SENIORS AND;
 - (3) FUNDING CAPITAL PURCHASES TO IMPROVE PARKS, FACILITIES, AND AMENITIES;
- PROVIDED THAT IN 2018 A PORTION OF THE 1.676 MILLS WILL BE USED TO MAKE THE FINAL PAYMENT ON THE DISTRICT'S GENERAL OBLIGATION DEBT; AND SHALL ALL DISTRICT REVENUES BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LIMITS PROVIDED BY LAW?

BALLOT ISSUE 5B

SHALL DEBT FOR SUN COUNTRY MEADOWS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BE INCREASED \$2,800,000 WITH A TOTAL REPAYMENT COST OF \$3,185,000, AND SHALL DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$189,252 ANNUALLY BASED ON 16.85 MILLS, OR BY SUCH LESSOR AMOUNT AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PAY THE DISTRICT'S DEBT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING, FINANCING OR REIMBURSING THE COSTS OF CONSTRUCTING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT: PAVED ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CULVERTS, AND DRAINAGE FACILITIES, PAVING, GRADING, RETAINING WALLS, FENCING, SIGNAGE AND STRIPING, AND ALL NECESSARY EQUIPMENT, LAND AND EASEMENTS; TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL AND PREMIUM WITH SUCH DEBT TO BEAR INTEREST AT A MAXIMUM NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT TO EXCEED 5.0%, SUCH INTEREST PER ANNUM, AND WHICH MAY COMPOUND ANNUALLY OR SEMIANNUALLY, AND SUCH DEBT TO MATURE, BE SUBJECT TO REDEMPTION WITH OR WITHOUT PREMIUM, AND BE ISSUED AND SOLD AT, ABOVE, OR BELOW PAR, SUCH DEBT TO BE ISSUED OR INCURRED AT ONE TIME OR FROM TIME TO TIME, TO BE PAID FROM ANY LEGALLY AVAILABLE REVENUES OF THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING THE PROCEEDS OF AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES; AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF ANY SUCH DEBT, ANY OTHER REVENUE USED TO PAY SUCH DEBT, AND INVESTMENT EARNINGS THEREON, BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING, OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, OR ANY OTHER LAW WHICH PURPORTS TO LIMIT THE DISTRICT'S REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES AS IT CURRENTLY EXISTS OR AS IT MAY BE AMENDED IN THE FUTURE, AND WITHOUT LIMITING IN ANY YEAR THE AMOUNT OF OTHER REVENUES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT?

BALLOT ISSUE 3G

WITHOUT INCREASING THE CURRENT TAX RATE OF 30.469 MILLS CURRENTLY IMPOSED FOR DEBT SERVICE ON BONDS, SHALL JOINT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 23JT TAXES BE INCREASED \$183,000 IN 2018, AND BY WHATEVER AMOUNTS ARE COLLECTED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023, BY IMPOSING A MILL LEVY, WHICH WHEN COMBINED WITH THE MILL LEVY FOR BONDS, DOES NOT EXCEED 30.469 MILLS, TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO:

- RETAIN AND RECRUIT HIGH QUALITY TEACHERS AND SUPPORT STAFF, AND
- RENOVATE AND REMODEL EXISTING EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES TO EXTEND ITS USEFUL LIFE;

BUT IN NO EVENT SHALL THE REVENUES FROM SUCH TAX INCREASE BE GREATER THAN THE AMOUNT PERMITTED BY STATE LAW; AND SHALL SUCH TAX INCREASE CONSTITUTE A VOTER APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE TO BE COLLECTED AND SPENT EACH YEAR WITHOUT REGARD TO THE LIMITS OF ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?
