1. Allow Elbert County unrestricted access to the site to conduct regular site inspections and be in compliance with all the requirements of the Elbert County Construction Standards and Specifications Manuel and Grading
2. Immediately cease land-disturbing activities upon receipt of a written Stop Work Order from an authorized representative of Elbert County. If a Stop Work Order is issued, this permit will be revoked if the Applicants are not in compliance with the Elbert County Over-Excavation Permit and Construction Standards and Specifications Manuel or if the applicants fail to take corrective action within the time specified on the written notification of such non-compliance.
3. Understand that any approval obtained by the Elbert County Road and Bridge Department does not negate your need to comply with the requirements of Sections 7 and 9 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, 16 U.S.C. 1531, et seq., as amended, or with any other applicable federal, state or local laws or regulations.
