

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Elbert County, Colorado, that we shall:

1. Apply for authority to establish a 5-Star Restaurant Certification Program at the earliest date possible in order to support the resumption of inside dining in our safely operated local restaurants; and

2. Appoint an Administrative Committee to oversee the implementation of a 5-Star Restaurant Certification Program that consists of owner/operators of local restaurants, leadership or representatives of the county and the towns, our local public health agency, and non-profit business support/economic development organizations; and

3. Work individually, and collaboratively with other local governments, business owners, and organizations to demand effective local control of COVID-19 response in a manner that safely makes life in the pandemic more sustainable for our citizens; and

4. Continue to recognize the rights of individuals to make decisions for themselves and that the key roles of local government is not to govern our citizens but to serve the people and protect their rights.
