

RESOLUTION--PROPOSED ROAD**TO VACATE AND ABANDON--W. FLOYD SHOEMAKER ET UX

WHEREAS, W. Floyd Shoemaker and Harriet E. Shoemaker did cause a subdivision called "Whispering Pine Acres" to be platted and filed under Reception number 173582 with the County Clerk and Recorder of Elbert County,

AND, WHEREAS they now seek to vacate a portion of said plat, including a portion designated "Proposed Rd.", and whereas that portion of said plat has never been opened, improved or accepted for public use by the Board of County Commissioners of Elbert County or used by the public and serves no public purpose,

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Elbert County, Colorado hereby vacate and abandon all of that portion of Whispering Pine Acres marked and designated on the plat filed under reception Number 173582 as a proposed road.

RESOLUTION--ABANDONING COUNTY ROADS.

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners of Elbert County, State of Colorado did on October 3, 1894 adopt the following resolution or order:

It is ordered by the Board that all Section Township & Range lines of the Public Domain be and the same are hereby declared open for public highways and the Clerk of the Board is ordered to draw up a deed to that effect and attest to same and record said deed in the records of his office,

AND, WHEREAS the present road system on this date is adequate for County needs and the Board of County Commissioners have determined that there is at present no need for any further Section, Township and Range line County Roads, other than those which are now and presently being maintained and operated as County Roads, that those not presently used as such should be abandoned.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Elbert County and State of Colorado that all Section lines, Range Lines and Township lines which are not now used for County Road purposes be and they hereby are abandoned as County Roads, It is further resolved that this resolution shall not effect the private rights of parties who may be utilizing section lines, Range lines or Township lines for purposes of access or travel thereon shall not be affected and further that all section lines, range lines and township lines now forming a part of the Elbert County Road system shall not be affected by this resolution.

Unanimously adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Elbert County this 4th day of November, 1963.
