**WHEREAS**, upon receipt of an application for special event permit, the County Clerk shall as required by C.R.S. §44-5-107(5)(c), access information made available on the state licensing authority's web site to determine the statewide permitting activity of the organization applying for the permit. The Authority shall consider compliance with C.R.S. §44-5-103(3), which restrict the number of permits issued to an organization within a calendar year to (15), before approving any application; and

**WHEREAS**, each application for special event liquor permit shall be accompanied by an application fee in an amount equal to the maximum local licensing fee established by C.R.S. §44-5-107(2)

**WHEREAS**, upon being granted, Special Event liquor licenses are subject to all other County liquor license requirements, rules, and regulations, ; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, by the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Elbert, State of Colorado, approves and authorizes this resolution for the purpose of Special Event Liquor Licensing, and therefore authorizes:

- 1) The local licensing authority (County Clerk) not be required to notify the state licensing authority to obtain the state licensing authority's approval or disapproval of applications for special events liquor license permits; and
- 2) All other requirements contained in the Colorado Liquor Code and associated regulations remain applicable.
