

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Primary Election Elbert County, Colorado Tuesday, June 28, 2022

Elections in Colorado are conducted by mail ballot with Voter Service Centers available for those who would like additional assistance or prefer to vote in person. See below for a list of locations and hours/days of operation.

For this Primary Election, ballots will be mailed the week of June 6 to all active registered voters affiliated with the Democratic or Republican Parties. Eligible electors who are not affiliated with a political party may declare an affiliation with a participating political party and vote in the primary election. All active registered Unaffiliated voters will be mailed the ballot of their preference, or if no preference is on record, both Democratic and Republican ballots will be mailed. Only one voted ballot may be returned. Ballots must be returned to the Clerk and Recorder no later than 7 p.m. on Election Day (Tuesday June 28) in order for your votes to be counted. Voters can return their ballot by mail or by dropping it off at any designated ballot drop-off location or Voter Service Center. Ballots received after 7 p.m. on Election Day will not be counted. Postmarks do not count as a received date. Adequate postage must be applied.

If you need to register to vote or update your registration, please do so at www.govotecolorado.gov. The Elbert County Elections Division recommends all voters review their information to ensure their mailing address is correct.

If you make a mistake, damage, or lose your ballot, you may request a replacement by emailing elections@elbertcounty-co.gov or calling 303-621-3127 by June 20, 2022, or by visiting a Voter Service Center during the hours/days of operation listed below.
