I WANT TO ADD AN ADU, BARN, OR SHOP (with facilities) ON MY PROPERTY AND TIE IT INTO MY EXISTING SEPTIC SYSTEM, WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

Below is the process for if you are wanting to add additional usage to your septic system

IF YOU ARE ADDING AN ADDITIONAL LIVING SPACE TO YOUR PROPERTY, PLEASE OBTAIN THE SECONDARY SITUS ADDRESS PRIOR TO OWTS SUBMITTAL. YOU CAN COMPLETE THE APPLICATION HERE: Elbert County CO (civicplus.com)

ELBERT COUNTY REGULATIONS

 Prior to approval from the Health Department, a USE PERMIT must be obtained for additions/remodels. You can find the OWTS application here: <u>Microsoft Word</u> -<u>Septic Permit Application Revised 4 4 19a (elbertcounty-co.gov)</u>

HOW TO:

To obtain the **USE PERMIT for additional usage**, the sizing AND functionality of the septic must be reviewed. To review the system and its functionality, the Health Department needs an **inspection report that was completed of the system within 1 year.** This report must be completed by a licensed inspector (If there is an inspection report on file that was completed within the year from a previous use permit that was issued, then we can use that report to determine if the system is sized appropriately for the additional usage) A list of licensed inspection companies can be found here: 2022-OWTS-Inspectors-Pumpers-(elbertcounty-co.gov))

Once the inspection report is completed, you will submit it to the Health Department with your **USE PERMIT** application. (Below is an example of how to complete the application when adding new structures)

If the Health Department approves the adding of a structure, an **ALTERATION PERMIT must be pulled for the tying in of the new structure to the existing septic**
