It shall be the sole responsibility of the property owner and/or permit holder to verify the all utilities and easements including water, sewer, well, septic, electric, phone, cable, fiber optic, and gas prior to excavation or construction of any structure and pull all necessary permits.



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Regarding Engineered Foundations

Elbert County requires that the following items be inspected by a State of Colorado Licensed Engineer;

- Open hole
- Pier caisson placement
- Footing size and steel placement
- Foundation wall
- Concrete encased electrode
- Beam placement
- Perimeter drains
- Water proofing
- Any addition inspections as requested by the Building Official
