Commissioner Dore moved to enter into Executive Session to discuss pending litigation.

After exiting Executive Session, various topics were discussed and a summary is as follows.

Commissioner Dore stated she had some questions she would like to ask, mentioning HHS, and would like to get these meetings done before a special study session. She suggested that staff come together to make common goals for 2016.

Consensus was to not do a special study session at this point.

Commissioner Dore also wanted gather information on Amendment 64 (the marijuana issue) and present her findings to the board. She wants to explore the options of permitting and regulating grow facilities in the County.

Commissioner Ross asked County manager, Ed Ehmann, when Poysti and Adams were due to visit the County. Mr. Ehmann reported they are scheduled to be on site November 2.




