



WHEREAS, the Elbert County Board of County Commissioners directs the placement on the ballot a question to refer to the voters of the County whether the limitations on terms of office for the current Elbert County Treasurer, Rick Pettitt, should be extended for a third term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ELBERT COUNTY that there shall be referred to the registered electors of the County the following proposal:

**Section 1.** THAT at the coordinated election to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, the County shall submit to the registered electors of the County the question of whether the limitations on terms of office for the current Elbert County Treasurer, Rick Pettitt, should be extended for an additional consecutive term in office, to serve a third term.

**Section 2.** THAT the ballot title and question that shall be referred to the registered electors of the County shall be as follows:

Shall the term limits imposed by state law and in Article XVIII, Section 11, of the Colorado Constitution on the office of Treasurer of Elbert County be modified so as to permit the current office holder of the office of Treasurer of Elbert County, Rick Pettitt, to seek and, if the voters of Elbert County choose to re-elect, to serve a third consecutive term?
